# School Uniform Policy



#### Preamble:

The School requires school uniforms to be worn to all school functions and sporting events unless the students are otherwise directed. The uniform must be clean and in good repair at all times creating a positive atmosphere for all. Early in the school year staff will review and remind all students of the policy.

#### Rules and expectations:

- All students must wear their school uniform and it must be visible to staff.
- If a student finds the school cold they are encouraged and permitted to wear additional layers of light clothing *under* their school uniform.
  KG-6 students are also encouraged to wear the red AGS zippered jacket. In grade 7-12 students may wear an alternate zippered jacket.

#### Reminders and exceptions:

- Either the standard school uniform or the school PE uniform can be worn. PE uniform consists of navy pants or shorts fitted just above the knees and a navy T-shirt. PE uniforms can only be worn on the days the student has PE. Mixing and matching the normal and PE uniforms is not allowed.
- Students participating in school-organized Special Event days (e.g. Orange Shirt Day, Pink Shirt Day, Character Day, etc.) are exempt from wearing the uniform on those days.
- Senior jackets may be worn by grads or siblings of former students if they wish.
- Students who are allergic to some item(s) of school clothing may have exceptions, however, medical documentation is required for such an exemption to be permitted.
- Students participating in after-school activities may wear their own (non-uniform) clothing.

#### Responsibilities and Consequences

- Mr. Tariq Ibrahim, teachers and administration are responsible for enforcing the policy.
- At any time if a student is not in proper uniform they may be permitted to enter class. They may be asked to call their parents and have them bring the proper uniform to school and only then will they be given permission to attend classes.
- Violation of this policy is listed in the *Code of Conduct* as a level one behavior.
- As a repeat offender it may quickly move to a level two behavior where the consequences become more serious.
- If the student refuses to respect the policy and the staff then the behavior may escalate to:
  - "Defying school authority and staff members". Further consequences will be applied.
