Dear Parents,

Yesterday AGS school administration attended a meeting with ADEK to be introduced to the operational protocols for protecting students as we prepare for a gradual return to in person learning. We received the materials to prepare for reopening later in the day.

All schools are required to complete a series of steps, before being approved to reopen. These include:

- Participation in mandatory ADEK Safety protocols training
- Submission of detailed safety and operational documents
- A formal readiness onsite inspection conducted by ADEK
- Final approval for re-opening from ADEK, once all requirements have been successfully met

Based on ADEK protocols we will be refining safety procedures for arrival, breaks, dismissal, as well as how we respond to any situations that may arise during the school day.


Our priority is to make sure that when we return to in person learning, it is done safely and thoughtfully for all members of our community.
